2018 marks 100 years since Parliament passed a law which allowed some women, and all men, to vote for the first time. A major exhibition, *Voice & Vote: Women's Place in Parliament* is being staged in Westminster Hall. Featuring a range of amazing interactive features, the exhibition will cover the campaign for votes for women and the representation of women in the House of Commons and the House of Lords. Throughout the exhibition, rare and previously unseen historic objects, pictures and archives from the Parliamentary collections and elsewhere will be on show. We will also be able to see the 'New Dawn' art installation by Mary Branson during our self-guided visit.
